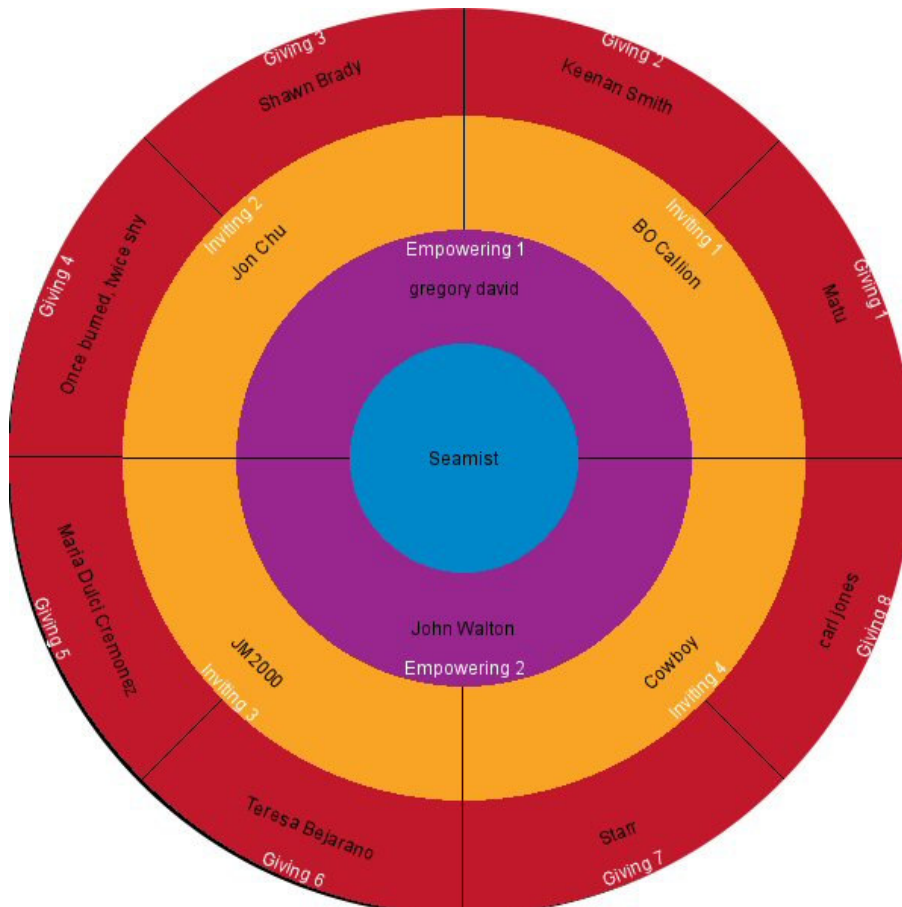
## Cycles of Abundance

### Cycles of Abundance

**Leverage \$50 into \$12,650 over and over again!**

**ConnectingUsAll.Org** is an interdenominational belief system meaning that we recognize all people of the world as being our brethren. It states, **“Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete (by the same measure that you use to give) withal it shall be measured to you again (in EVERY way, you shall receive from others accordingly).”** Through the Classic Cycles of Abundance, you are empowered to generate **\$12,650.00 repeatedly from a one-time, out-of pocket gift of \$50.** This is **NOT** MLM or Network Marketing. There is **NO** selling, **NO** recruiting, **NO** convincing, and **NO** hype. **Plus, giving is TOTALLY legal and tax-free!** (See IRS Pub 950 at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov)) You only need to invite two *like-minded* people who are willing to duplicate your efforts. They will follow you repeatedly through the five cycles. You can invite as many people as you'd like – it will speed up your progression through out the cycles. **Once you enter the recycling phase, you have the potential to receive infinite abundance according to the belief system.**

## CUA Classic Cycle of Abundance

The Classic Cycle of Abundance is automated and made up of 4 concentric circles or rings that contain fifteen positions. The first ring contains eight giving positions. You enter one of these positions when you are invited into the activity *before* gifting at the one-time, out-of-pocket gift of \$50. Once you gift the receiver in the center of the cycle, you advance into the inviting ring where there are 4 positions. In this ring, you invite your first person (your invitee) that gifts the person who has now advanced into the center. When your first invitee gifts their receiver, they advance into the Inviting ring. This "pushes" you into the Empowering ring where there are two positions. In the Empowering ring, you help or "empower" your invitee(s) to obtain their two people. This is also where you are required to invite your second person if you only have one invitee. When your first invitee obtains their first person, you advance to the Receiving position. You begin to receive \$50 gifts from those in the 8 Giving positions as they come into the cycle (\$400 total). Once your second invitee enters the cycle with their \$50 gift -- you can progress into the higher gifting cycles and re-enter each cycle. Without your second invitee, your progress through the higher cycles may be delayed.

People move in and out of each ring as they move on to higher gifting cycles. When you reach the center of any cycle, eight people in the Giving ring will gift you at the denomination of that cycle. This could be \$50, \$100, \$250, \$500, \$1,000. You receive eight gifts of each denomination per cycle (totaling \$400, \$800, \$2,000, \$4,000, and \$8,000).

Each step is replicated in every cycle. Once you enter forward progression (upon receiving your fourth gift) and recycling (upon receiving your sixth gift), your group (your invitees, their invitees, etc.) will follow you through the process and into the higher gifting cycles. Everyone saves a portion of the gifts they have received to re-enter new cycles. Before you have progressed to the \$1,000 cycle, you will already be on another \$50, \$100, \$250, \$500, and finally a new \$1,000 cycle. There is no break or lull in the cycles -- they are perpetual in the truest sense of the word. Each participant that you invite and they invite and so on -- will always follow you onto the new cycles. The old cycles will be completed once they are filled. A cycle does not have to be filled in order for you to progress to a new cycle.

**Cycle One** is the \$50 cycle. Everyone starts on this cycle by giving a one-time, out-of-pocket gift of \$50 to the Receiving position. By the time you complete this cycle you will have received 8 \$50 gifts totaling \$400. **Cycle Two** is the \$100 cycle. To enter this cycle, you will save \$100 from the \$400 you received, and gift the Receiver of this cycle. By the time you complete this cycle you will be in the center position and will have received 8 \$100 gifts totaling \$800.

In addition to the \$100 you save from the \$800 you have received -- you should also save an extra \$50 for re-entry into another \$50 cycle. That is \$150 total you should put aside from your first cycle. If you invite one person, they invite one person, and they invite one person -- you will enter the Receiving position of the cycle without your second person. You could invite two who invites one, or one who invites two. There are three steps to advance into the Receiving position (Giving, Inviting, and Empowering). You start out in the giving phase once you give you advance to the inviting phase. Once you invite you advance to the empowering phase, once they invite you advance to the receiving phase (the center) and you will receive eight gifts from anyone who comes in on that cycle regardless of who invited them, you or your invitees.

If you or anyone in your group invites more than two people, it pushes you through the cycles at a faster rate. You will eventually be on dozens of cycles when this happens. Because of the automatic, forward re-entry to a higher cycle after receiving your fourth gift -- and the automatic progression to a new cycle after you receive your sixth gift -- **THE POSSIBILITIES ARE ENDLESS.**

For example, say you start out on the \$50 cycle and invite two *like-minded* people who do the same. When you receive your fourth gift, you will move to the \$100 cycle and gift the receiver \$100. When you receive your sixth gift on the \$50 cycle, you will move to another \$50 cycle and gift the receiver \$50. That is \$150 you should save from the \$400 you received in the first cycle. This leaves you a total of \$250. It is the same on each cycle only in higher denominations. When you receive your fourth gift on the \$100 cycle (\$400 total), you will move to the \$250 cycle and gift the person in the center \$250. When you receive your sixth gift on the \$100 cycle you will move to another \$100 cycle and gift the center \$100. That's \$350 you should save from the \$800 you received in the \$100 cycle, leaving you a grand total of \$700. **The best strategy is to save your first gifts for re-entry into the new cycles and keep the remaining gifts for yourself.** This way you will always have enough to gift forward without coming out-of-pocket. If you are unable to gift the receiver of each new cycle, they can ask to have you removed from the cycle in order to keep the cycles moving. You can join a new cycle when you are ready to participate. Because of all the forward re-entry into new cycles, our intent is to get participants to a place where they are receiving gifts consistently, it doesn't matter which cycle the gifts come from or in what order. The tracking system always fills the oldest cycles first but it doesn't require you to complete one cycle before you join another one.

### **Here's How Your One-Time, Out-of-Pocket Gift of \$50 Will Leverage Into \$12,650**

1. Give \$50 once out-of-pocket, 8 people will give you \$50 = \$400. You gift \$150 (\$100 goes into the next cycle, \$50 re-enters the current cycle) – You keep \$250, for a total of \$250.
2. Give \$100 of what you already received, 8 people will give you \$100 = \$800. You gift \$350 (\$250 goes into the next cycle, \$100 re-enters the current cycle) – You keep \$450, for a total of \$700.
3. Give \$250 of what you already received, 8 people will give you \$250 = \$2,000. You gift \$750 (\$500 goes into the next cycle, \$250 re-enters the current cycle) – You keep \$1,250, for a total of \$2,200.
4. Give \$500 of what you already received, 8 people will give you \$500 = \$4,000. You gift \$1,500 (\$1,000 goes into the next cycle, \$500 re-enters the current cycle) – You keep \$2,500, for a total of \$5,650.
5. Give \$1,000 of what you already received, 8 people will give you \$1,000 = \$8,000. \$1,000 re-enters the current cycle) – You keep \$7,000, for a total of \$12,650.

By this time, you are already recycling by being on ten new cycles with the same people following you. Remember every time you join a new cycle, you go forward once you receive your 4<sup>th</sup> gift and you go back to the same cycle when you receive your 6<sup>th</sup> gift.

### **All This For Giving \$50 Out-of-Pocket, and Inviting 2 Others Who Are Like-Minded!**

The previous explanation takes into account the gifts you will give to enter new cycles.

**The recycling process is perpetual.** As you constantly move onto new cycles, you will be in several recycling phases with your invitees and their invitees following you to each new cycle. **This will take some time and will not happen overnight.** One Pastor in the activity received \$13,000 his first month however, he is a Pastor and had many invitees from his church that participated. You will also reach a

stage where you will begin to merge into the collective of older members. You will enter cycles of these members who will seem to appear out of nowhere and you will gift the receiver of these cycles. You will also begin to receive gifts from members whom you have no idea who invited them.

We also have the Express Model that is four gifts per cycle, it is not automated in that you will have to manually request a new cycle each time the old one completes. It is best to do this upon receiving your third gift. You can request as many of the Express cycles as you want and you should coordinate this with your team so that they will follow you onto this model. The levels on the Express are \$50, \$100, \$250 and \$500.

All gifts are sent according to your specification, (cashiers check or money order), within 3 days by a private courier that provides a tracking number (UPS, FedEx, DHL or USPS). This prevents gifts from being lost in route. Each participant should submit their gift and provide a verifiable tracking number within 72 hours of becoming active on a cycle. When it is your turn to be gifted you will appreciate receiving it within 3 days. We can also use Alert Pay in order to speed up the gifting process. It is free to join and much more reasonable in price to send a gift. Please do not send cash, there was one lady who sent a \$500 cash gift by FedEx. The recipient received an empty envelope, somewhere en route the cash was taken out. The gift could not be marked as received and the sender had to come out-of-pocket to send the gift again.

**EXTREMELY IMPORTANT: Remember to pay your \$16 subscription fee for your website and to maintain access to your back office.** When you request to join a cycle you will be given the opportunity to pay your subscription fee. When a member becomes inactive or drops out, their gift will roll up to the next qualifying member. (Your position never stops receiving gifts even when you are deactivated as long as you submitted your first gift). If one of your invitees becomes inactive, replace them so that you can maintain two active participants.

I like to use the 3-month option when paying my fees. Thirty days can come around so fast it is easy to forget. One participant forgot to pay her hosting fee and was deactivated for two days, she missed out on two gifts. Once you join a cycle, you have committed to following the steps in the progression. Simply invite two *like-minded* people and save a portion of your gifts to be prepared for the next level.

This system is dependent upon consistent interaction within the cycles. This creates perpetual prosperity for all participants in a timely manner. If everyone came into the program with his or her two people, it could literally work within a matter of weeks. We have seen it happen in a matter of hours when the right, like-minded individuals come together as a group.

### **The Power Of Giving Is Awesome!**

You will never go back to selling products and filing a Schedule C once you experience the power of giving. **The best part is it's all tax-free.** All gifts are sent privately and directly from one member to another. The tracking system is also a contact management system between participants. It tracks each cycle then notifies you when you have a gift pending from a participant who will then contact you through our network to make arrangements to send your gift. Remember the network is free to join and it gives people a chance to get to know us before they decide to join a cycle.

## To Get Started, Follow These Three Simple Steps:

**STEP 1:** Contact your Inviter via email and request an invitation into the activity.

**STEP 2:** When you receive your invitation click on the link in the email, this will take you to the home site where you will click on the Get Started link and fill out a short form.

**STEP 3:** Find two *like-minded* people. Login to your profile then click the **Invite** link at the top of your profile page. Enter the name and email address of someone you wish to invite, the system will email them the invitation link that will connect them to you. They will also receive three email reminders over the course of one month.
